Features available in partially subsidised hearing devices vary depending on the type of device. Some of the additional features available in partially subsidised hearing devices may include

- Switchable or adaptive directional microphones
- Adaptive noise reduction
- Transient noise reduction
- Automatic multi-memory
- Automatic environmental adaptation
- Wireless connectivity
- Super directional microphones
- Frequency transposition/compression
- Trainability/environmental learning
- Bilateral processing/synchronisation
- At least one form of adaptive noise reduction, and
- Bilateral processing/synchronisation.
